### "It's time to go back to Kaua'i."

Spoken firmly, these were Ada Lum's words early in 2009. Although she and others had occasionally spoken there, it had been years since BIH had offered a regular class on the Garden Isle. After much prayer, planning, and the enthusiastic help of Katy Corbett and Dr. Sharon on Kaua'i, BIH was able to schedule a class this fall, held in the lovely Kalaheo home of a family whose members were equally committed to Bible study.

We were eager to know how they felt about the class, and asked Katy for a report. Here is her response:

*"For eight weeks, 40 people on the Garden Island of Kaua'i met and studied under Ada Lum and Clive Cowell. Ada led studies on "the scandalous Jesus" from the Gospel of Luke, and Clive took us through the Book of Hosea. The students were enthusiastic to learn*
