Announcing New Certificate Program -"Certificate in Mentored Ministry" (CMM)

his invaluable Certificate program is tailor-made to assist students in honing in on their ministry calling. It is a supervised practicum or internship in Christian ministry, addressing broad or specialized fields of study. The program requires taking 4 BIH classes and 8 mentored ministry program credits, earned from hours invested in any variety of ministries: Christian schools, parachurch, short-term mission, and church. Students will meet regularly with their ministry supervisor and BIH admin. Prerequisite: Completion of CBS program.

Now Offering "Flex Credit Hours" for Certificate programs – BIH Networking

Our CBS or CMM students may earn credit hours for attending seminars and conferences hosted by evangelical local ministries. One credit is equivalent to 16 hours of seminar attendance. A maximum of two credits may be earned per Certificate program.

BIH Networking ministries include: Evidence and Answers, Hawaiian Islands Ministries (HIM), Just Show Up (JSU), and Alec & Belle Waterhouse Lectures. (BIH Seminars also award Flex Credit Hours)
