### A Little Bit of Greek

Are you a *Greek-a-phobe*? Terrified at the thought of the language and mystified as to why God would choose such a difficult language for the New Testament? Do you ask: Why didn't He just use English?

In this course, we will help take steps to overcoming an irrational fear of Greek by looking at NT verses and topics where knowing Greek really matters. Are there three kinds of love in Greek? Where does the Bible say the Son of God always existed? What is Jesus telling us to do in the Great Commission? We will not be learning Greek. Instead, we will be learning about this language, why it is the language of the New Testament, and how a better understanding of it can give us a better understanding of God's Word.

It is a collection of songs that is called the "Prayer Book of the Bible." It contains many different kinds of prayers representing the entire range of human emotions. There are psalms that express gratitude and praise as well as psalms that express lament and complaint. Theologically, the book of Psalms challenges our present world of anxiety, scarcity, greed, self-sufficiency, denial and despair with trust, faith, promise of abundance, dependence on God, an insistence on telling the truth, a world of hope, and life-giving remembering.
