


A Jubilant Milestone for BIH! Are you ready?

his November 5th is "THE Date" that BIH has highlighted, spotlighted, then floodlighted for more than a year. Now, entering the final stage of planning and preparation, nothing has consumed us more than that date of the 50-year Anniversary Celebration. Prayers, vision, doubt, then more prayer underscore such a mammoth task and the difficulties that go along with it. Along with lockdowns, relationships at home became strained and social connections grew distant. Our livelihoods, education, careers, and society look different now, even reshaped and redefined in some cases.

As a result of all the changes and uncertainty, I must admit that even my own state of mental health and wellbeing were impacted. Despite attempts to shore up my heart and head in God's Word and promises, I could still feel a malaise of "uncertainty" haze over my mind's eye. The prolonged feelings brought me back to my days in High School. Remember "Senioritis?"



For the apostle Paul and the church, uncertain times in varying degrees was a fact of life, short of heaven. To ensure the message about Jesus would continue, Paul entrusted his faith and God's Word into the next generation, encouraging Titus to instruct

and train others for godliness and the gospel "in the present age," while waiting for the return of Christ, "our blessed hope" (Titus 2:13, cf. vvs. 11-15, ESV).


