The Fear of the Lord - My Journey By Marti Ann Koizumi

am immensely thankful for the Bible Institute of Hawaii and the blessings it has brought into my life. This remarkable community of devoted teachers and passionate students, all bound by a shared love for Jesus, has been a true gift from God.

A few years ago, I was reading my Bible during my quiet time, and I remember asking the Lord, "What does the fear of the Lord actually mean?" I was reading Proverbs 1:7, which states, "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge; Fools despise wisdom and instruction." (NASB). I could feel the Holy Spirit's conviction to want to learn more. What was this "fear of the Lord" that was connected to "knowledge"?

Shortly after, this Bible Scripture seemed to resonate even more as I listened to a sermon on YouTube. The preacher passionately emphasized the need for more churches to teach about the fear of the Lord, a sentiment that resonated deeply. That came at the right time. Again, I wanted to learn more as it all seemed to tie in together. Little did I know that God knew exactly what I needed and what I was ready for. He was preparing to lead me down a different path than the one I was on.

Around the same time, I had an opportunity to attend "Just Show Up", a captivating Bible reading ministry hosted by First Presbyterian Church of Honolulu. I had never experienced anything so wonderful! During one of the sessions, Jason Sumner mentioned that there was an event at "Just Show Up" for BIH. I noted it down as I wanted to know more about BIH. I visited their website and discovered that they offered an array of enriching classes led by seasoned educators.

My small group leader from church suggested I take BIH classes. Her words were like seeds planted in soil. God watered the soil in my heart which eventually led me to enroll in classes and ultimately pursue a Certificate in Biblical Studies.

I enrolled in Pastor Gary Lau's class. My mindset began to change and reshape my perspective on reading the Bible. The Bible is a book about Jesus, not about me. God orchestrated my path, surrounding me with wise and godly mentors like Pastor Gary and Dr. Cuevas. Their wisdom and guidance came at a much-needed time in my life. In Dr. Cuevas' Ecclesiastes class, I learned that the fear of the Lord starts with a good understanding about God's sovereignty. He has control over

everything. It calls for our reverence, worship, awe, and respect for God. In "Proverbs: An Introduction and Commentary," Derek Kidner provides valuable insights. He defines the fear of the Lord as "a worshiping submission (fear) to the God of the covenant who has revealed Himself by name (the Lord, i.e., Yahweh: Exod. 3:13-15)" (56).

I cannot express how much of an honor it has been to meet and learn from Pastor Rodney Wong, Pastor Gary Lau, Dr. J.R. Cuevas, Pastor Todd Capen, Drs. Rick and Martha Stinton, Dr. Chaplain Elijah Pierick, Nanette Williams, Dr. James Kwong, Dr. Matt Sanders, Dr. Gary Manning, Pastor Earl Morihara, Dr. Randy Furushima, and Sanford Tom. Not only have I learned to study the Bible more accurately, but I have been greatly encouraged by observing all my teachers living as exemplary godly men and women for the Lord. Additionally, my heart has been touched by numerous wonderful classmates. I am very grateful for the friendships I have formed. It has been an incredible privilege to be part of such a loving, warm, and caring group of people.

I have learned what the "fear of the Lord" is. God put me on a journey, and what I discovered was more than I could have ever asked for or imagined. It reminds me of Paul praising God for the Gentile's understanding of the gospel in Ephesians 3:20. He said it best, "Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us, to Him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever! Amen" (NIV).
