### ACTS: The Unfinished Story 《使徒行传：未完成的故事》

This course is a seven-session journey into one of the most powerful books in the Bible. Participants will explore the book of Acts and discover how a small group of ordinary people—empowered by the Spirit of God—transformed the world.

Through the story of the early church, this course invites participants to rediscover the courage, faith, and mission of the first believers. More than a Bible study, it is an invitation to see how the story of Acts continues today—and how each believer may take part in the next chapter of God's work.

The course is designed for believers who desire to grow in their understanding of the early church and the ongoing mission of God. *The class will be conducted in Mandarin.*

This course introduces Paul's letter to the Ephesians, focusing on the theology of salvation, the unity of the church, and the lordship of Christ. Participants will explore key passages and discover the spiritual blessings believers have in Christ and the calling of the church as God's people.

There is no prerequisite for this course, and there are no musical skill-level requirements. Please register even if you are brand new to music or a seasoned performer. This course is the first of two

skills-focused courses in this five-course Music Ministry series (see “New Music Ministry Curriculum” elsewhere in this newsletter).

Students will be introduced to essential music theory and apply it in songwriting tasks throughout the course. Topics include song structures, musical dynamics, harmonies, melodies, scales and why they matter, songwriting, the relationship between music and its message, the difference between congregational music and personal music, and how to create a captivating yet biblical time of praise.
